Supporting sustainable carbon farming practices

Farmers are battling eroding soils, extreme weather and rising pressure to cut emissions. Smart Carbon Farming works with them directly, testing practices which boost carbon storage on 15 pilot farms across North-West Europe.

By measuring what works in real fields, the project helps farmers rebuild healthy soils, store more carbon and earn new income. With 50 farmers trained, it shows climate-friendly farming can also be productive and profitable.
